The geometrical shapes of **Norma** table top set creates an aura around the interiors where they are used. The aura is reflected in the flowers in the vase and the fruits or food in the bowls.

Norma comes in 6 different forms and two different silvered glass finishes: silver and smoky lime green silvered glass

The tea set **Chado** for **Verreum** is designed for the celebration of drinking tea. The origin of its name **Chado** is based on the Japanese designation of tea ceremony. It is a set of archaic and simple designed objects consisting of a tea cup, milk jug, tea pot, cookie bowl and a metal tray. My aim was to concentrate on the materials like silvered glass and colored frosted glass combined with marble and brass. Every object of this set is made of its most suitable material. The cup for example is made of double walled silvered glass, the tray of metal spanned brass. **Chado** is created for a ritual.

The real matter of a vase is its contents. The glass layerings of **Corolle** refer to the petals forming the dress of the flower. Materials or techniques combinations are always present in my work, and the **Corolle** collection shows in very few elements the capacities of the glass. The usual transparency becomes opaque where the pattern appears while the colors overlap and reflect on each other.

Thus **Corolle** can be also contemplated without a bouquet.
